



Alabama High School Rodeo Association Scholarship Information

Dear AHSRA Seniors,

We are excited to offer over \$16,000 in scholarships this year. Please look at the detailed list below and decide which scholarships you would like to apply for. We have included the list of scholarships, application process, and application for you to complete. Please follow the directions and get your documents back in so we can help you further your education. Each of you will be missed next year. We are excited about finals, and we wish you the best! Remember, you will have an interview, your appointment time will be sent to you a few days before the interviews. IF you have any questions, ***please contact Kim De Felix or Janet Fugate.***

Application Process:

You will need to complete a Google Form to state your interest in applying for scholarships. This Google Form will be available on **MAY 5TH** and Must be completed ***no later than May 16th*** in order for you to secure an interview time.

All applications, essays, college letter/trade letter of acceptance, and statements of interest must be turned in at Senior Check-In at State Finals. **You must include the following in a manilla envelope with your name on the outside. Failure to include ANY of these documents in your envelope WILL be AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION FOR THE APPLICANT FROM RECEIVING A SCHOLARSHIP:** *Please include a completed written or typed application, official high school/homeschool transcript, transcript can be sealed from the school (do not open it) or a transcript pulled from school records like homeschool offers, include college/trade school acceptance letter, and any applicable essays.* Take those documents, make 3 copies of each of the documents, also make a copy of the sealed transcript if one is enclosed. You should check off the scholarships you are applying for on the sheet you have and return the sheet in the packet as well. So, in doing this, you should have your copy and a copy for each judge (3) making it a total of 4 total copies. Place the copy for each judge in a separate "pocket paper notebook". Place your application in the left-side pocket and all other documents in the right-side pocket with your transcript on top.

Interviews will take place at the State Finals. You should wear western attire with your back number for your interview. Applicants will be given a set time for interviews, you will show up with your three folders for the judges, along with your main copy.

SELECTION:

The judges will consider each application for each scholarship. The National Director along with the scholarship committee will consider all AHSRA Merit applications which are submitted. All scholarship recipients will be awarded at the Gala during State Finals on **Friday, May 30th**. ***You must be present in order to accept any scholarships you win.***
